


THREE INDISPENSABLE FACTORS FOR BALANCED TEACHING

"For Ezra had set his heart to study the law of the Lord, and to practice it, and to teach His statutes and ordinances in Israel."
Ezra 7:10 (NASB)

Those who aspire to be effective teachers must keep the following three things in balance. Like the legs on a three-legged stool, each of these areas is vitally related to the others and impacts the stability of the stool. The absence of or deficiency in any of the three areas will impact the effectiveness of your teaching.

*This area concerns the **content** under consideration and how you interact with that content. Your investment of time in this area will impact the effectiveness of your teaching.*



*This area concerns the **character** of the teacher. Character impacts credibility and therefore the effectiveness of the teacher.*

*This area concerns **communication**. Effective communication must make allowance for the ways in which individuals learn.*
